## RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CHARTERS ABOARD "KOSTALOTA"

Everything you require for fishing is provided: bait, tackle, licences and tuition where required. Listed below are some suggestions to help make your day enjoyable and successful.

Reef Fishing Charters depart at 6am so you will need to be at the boat in Kiama Harbour at approx 5.50am. \* Return time is about 1.30-2pm. Please park at 90 degrees to the stone retaining wall opposite the boat.

Maintain 1.5m social distancing whilst waiting and also aboard. Hands to be sanitised, prior to boarding. Covid19 check-in on your phone via Service NSW QR code.

Seasickness medication: Available from Chemists. Follow the instructions

-usually to be taken with food ½-1 hour before departure. Chewing gum helps keep a pleasant taste in the mouth

Have a good night's sleep before and have breakfast prior to trip.

Not lots of milk or orange juice. Tea/Coffee & toast is fine

Wear old shoes and woollen socks so it doesn't matter if they get wet. Rubber gumboots are quite good.

**Bring**: Clothing for every weather possibility no matter what season or forecast

Full wet weather gear, warm clothes, sunnies, hat/beanie and sunscreen.

Snacks, sandwiches, soft drinks or beers (in moderation). Morning tea is served but it is a long day on only a cuppa and a bikkie or two.

An esky to take your fish home in. Your quality fish are gilled & gutted but you will need a knife and a scaler if you want to fillet or scale them before you go home.

\* Refunds or transferral of payment only if operator cancels charter due to weather, breakdown, skipper illness or government declared shutdown. If you commit to a particular day for your fishing trip & have to cancel, for any reason, you will forfeit any payment.
